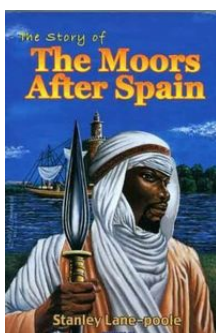


THE STORY OF THE MOORS AFTER SPAIN
