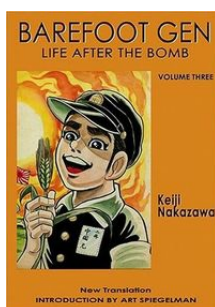


BAREFOOT GEN, VOLUME THREE: LIFE AFTER THE BOMB
