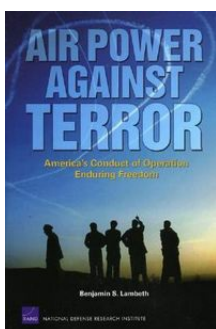


# AIR POWER AGAINST TERROR: AMERICA'S CONDUCT OF OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM
