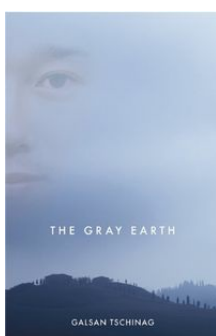


# THE GRAY EARTH
