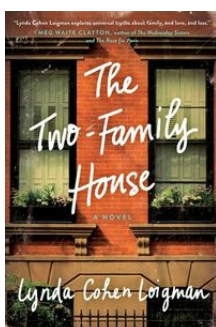


THE TWO-FAMILY HOUSE
